



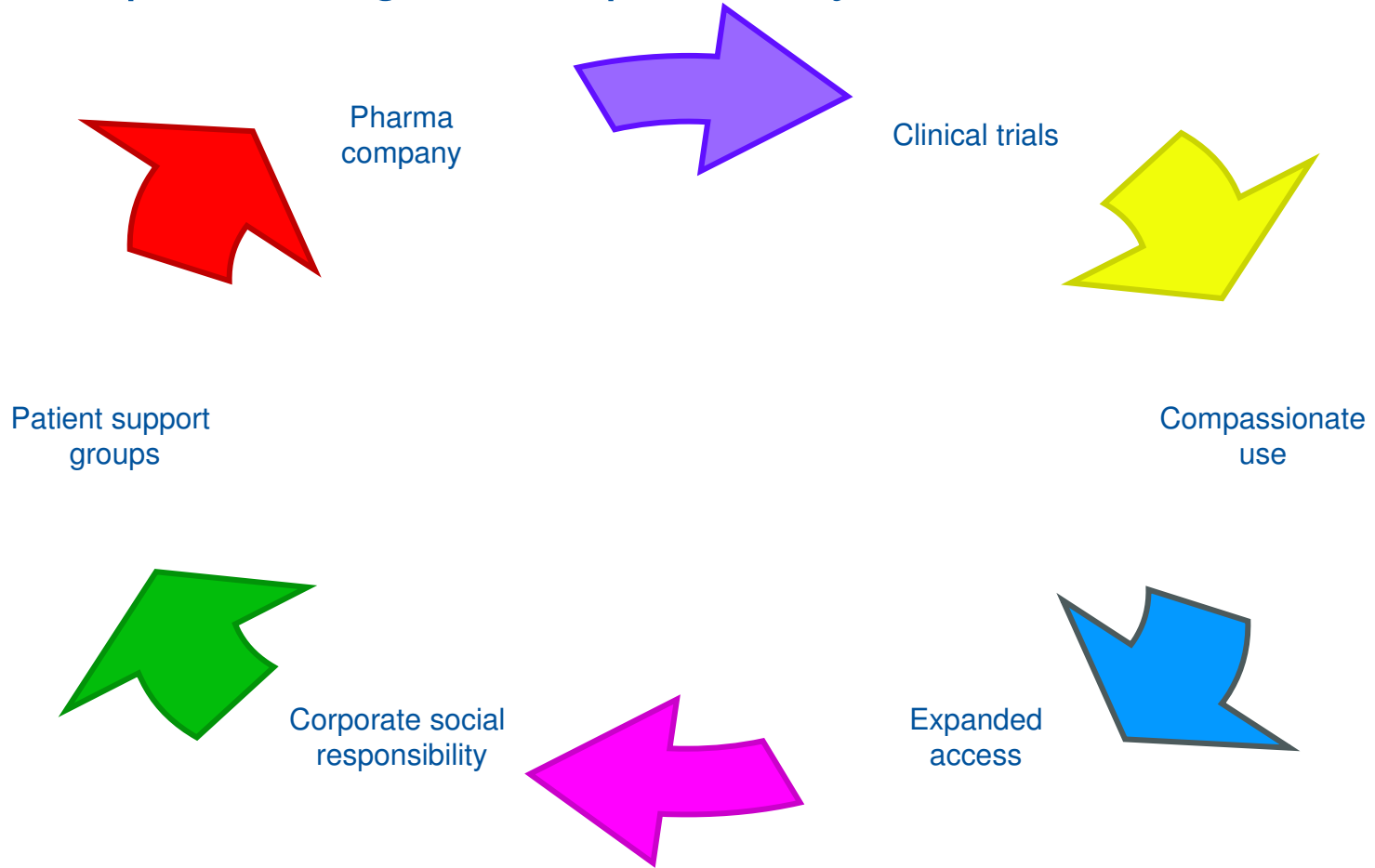

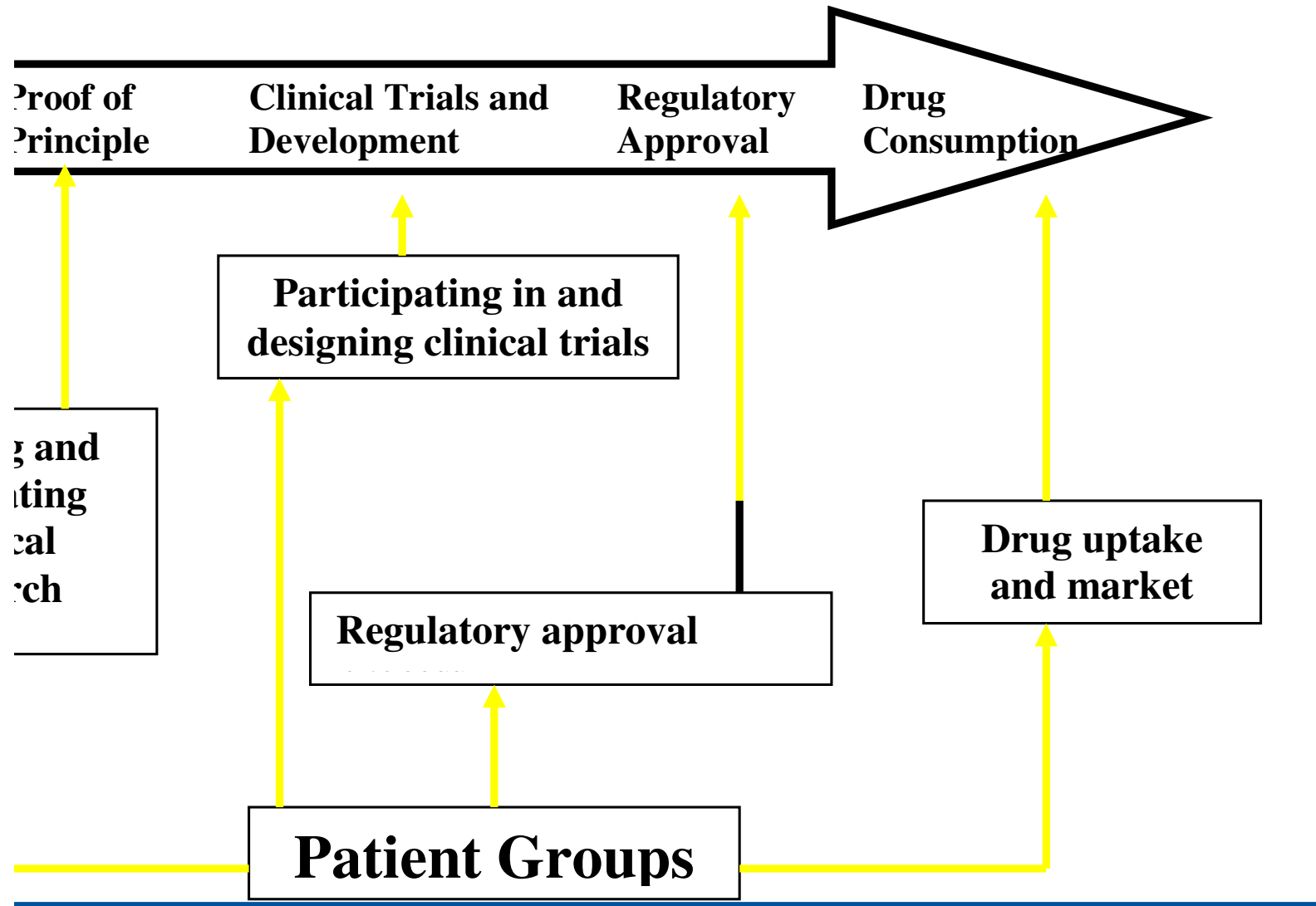




# Orphan Drugs

- Strong collaborative relationship between:
  - patients
  - physicians
  - pharma
- Frequent direct contact at advisory boards, physician meetings and patient support groups
- Relationships can be stressed if clinical trials are not successful

# Patient Groups and the Innovation Process





## Compassionate Use

- Important for patients with life threatening illnesses
- Single patient use is costly and difficult to obtain
- Provides little value to the drug development process
- May raise unfounded safety concerns
- Compassionate use may last for years



## Expanded Access

- Phase III studies completed
- Commercial drug available
- Accountability can be difficult
- Costly to companies



# Corporate Social Responsibility

- Broad availability of medication
- Medication access programs
- Unbiased product education for HCP's and patients
- Unrestricted financial support for patient groups
- Investigator sponsored trial support
